



Job Opportunity for Full-Time Employment - Land Surveyor (PLS / LSIT)

Job Description:

AESI is seeking a talented full-time land surveyor with 2+ years' experience. This position will be involved with a wide range of typical surveying work along with other surveyors, surveying interns, and engineering staff within the company. The candidate should have their PLS license or LSIT credential or the ability to obtain within 6 months.

Salary Range:

\$45,000 - \$70,000 depending on experience.

Responsibilities:

The land surveyor position includes both office and field responsibilities. Office duties will include general correspondence, courthouse records research, field survey preparations, survey calculations, data management, and preparation of easement exhibits, certificate of survey drawings, and subdivision plats. Duties may also include project management, client interaction, business development, project acquisition and billing, meetings, project review, quality control, supervision, etc. Field duties will include boundary surveys, topographic surveys, ALTA surveys, design surveys, residential subdivisions, and construction staking. This person must be a motivated, personable, hard-working, quality-oriented and self-motivated team player and be willing to work on a variety of civil-related projects. This position will be based out of our Bozeman office, but will include regional travel.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Land Surveyor Intern (LSI) or Licensed Professional Land Surveyor (PLS) in Montana required, or ability to obtain within 6 months. PLS preferred.
- 2+ years' land surveying experience.
- Ability to work in all weather conditions and mountainous terrain.
- Requires excellent computer and technical skills. Microsoft Office Suite (Word and Excel minimum) are required. Must be proficient in AutoCAD Civil 3D 2017 or newer. Autodesk Vault Professional familiarity is beneficial. Experience with Trimble field equipment and Trimble Business Center software preferred.
- High level of personal responsibility, accountability, and analytical aptitude.
- Interpersonal skills to meet and communicate effectively (both written and verbal) with employees, managers, contractors, and clients.
